Guest Speaker: Bishop Leroy Greenaway



Leroy Victor Stephen Greenaway was born and raised in Trinidad. A son of a Pentecostal minister Leroy was converted at the early age of twelve. He began preaching around the age of fourteen and was called to his first pastorate at the age of nineteen.

After attending school in Trinidad where he majored in the languages, he then migrated to Cleveland Tennessee, USA where he attended Tomlinson College and Lee University respectively. He graduated from Lee University in 1981 with a BA in Sociology magna cum laude and a minor in Biblical Studies. In 2010 he graduated from the Palmer Theological Seminary with a Master's of Divinity degree. He is presently pursuing a doctoral degree from Gordon Conwell University.

A minister in the Church of God of Prophecy, Leroy has traveled extensively, preaching the gospel throughout the Caribbean, the US, Canada and England, serving as evangelist, camp meeting speaker, and youth camp evangelist.

In 1985 he migrated to Toronto, Canada to take up a position as Youth Pastor of the Pape Avenue Church of God of Prophecy. The same year he was asked to accept a pastorate in Montreal, Quebec. After 17 years the Montreal West congregation grew from 89 to over 300 under the ministry of Bishop Greenaway. In July 2002 he was appointed as Regional Overseer to the Mid-Atlantic Region, where he served for 12 years. On December 1st, 2014 he was reassigned to the North East Region where he presently serves the areas of Bermuda, Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island and Vermont.

He is married to the former Christina Kelly of Birmingham, England. They are blessed to have two beautiful children, Jessica a graduate of Nyack College, with a BA in Sociology and pursuing a Masters in Guidance Counseling. Their son James is a senior at Eastern University, Pennsylvania.

Guest Speaker: Minister Morais Cassell



Morais Cassell gave his heart to the Lord at the age of fourteen in Brooklyn, New York, where he began ministering to young people. He served as Teen Ministry Director, Drama Ministry Coordinator and Youth Group Leader. At the end of high school, Morais relocated to Buffalo, NY to pursue an undergraduate degree. He holds a Bachelor of Arts in Biology and Religious Studies. Morais went on to complete graduate school and received a Master's of Science, in Science Education. Morais continued his graduate studies and also holds a Master's of Arts degree in Professional Counseling with a concentration in crisis counseling. He is currently in the process of earning his doctorate, a Ph.D. in Counseling and Pastoral Care. Morais accepted his call to full-time ministry and served in Buffalo, at a Christian Academy as Chapel speaker, Dean and Teacher (Science and Bible). Morais has served in various ministry positions including District and Local Youth Director, Christian Education Teacher and Outreach Ministries Director. Morais recently served as the Church of God of Prophecy Northeast (seven states) and Bermuda Regional Youth and Transitions Ministries Director.

Morais currently resides in Albany, New York, U.S.A., along with his wife Diane, who serves as the Northeast Region Music Ministries coordinator. Morais currently serves at the Church of God of Prophecy Northeast Region Evangelism and Youth Camp Director. He loves young people and travels extensively preaching and teaching at revivals, retreats, conferences, camps, leadership training events and in prisons across the U.S.A. His ministry has led him to many countries/nations including Canada, Germany, U.S. Virgin Islands (St. Thomas, St. Croix), British Virgin Islands (Tortola), St. Lucia, Antigua, Jamaica, Cyprus, Nigeria, the Bahamas, Honduras (Central America), Peru, Venezuela and the Ukraine.

Those who know Minister John Lee, Jr. would tell you that he wears many hats. He's a disciple, evangelist, teacher, worship leader, mentor, student, musician, son, brother, and friend.
